Construction begins on the new Grey Bruce Health Unit which is targeted for LEED Gold

Chosen from 38 Architectural proposals, Salter Pilon and in association with Lett Architects were commissioned in the summer of 2005 to provide full-service consulting services for the new 60,000 square foot Grey-Bruce Health Unit in Owen Sound. Our innovative design includes collection of rainwater for use in waterclosets and the use of natural ventilation in the office spaces. The current design reduces energy consumption by 53% of the Model National Energy Building Code. The project is targeted for LEED Gold. This innovative project which was tendered for \$13.89 million in December 2006 is currently under construction with a scheduled completion in October 2008.
